AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 3, relative to the general assembly.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. In honor of her years of service to the Tennessee House of Representatives, including serving as the first female Speaker of the House in Tennessee history, the new public space constructed on top of the parking garage attached to the Cordell Hull Building is designated the "Beth Harwell Plaza".

SECTION 2. In honor of his years of service to the Tennessee General Assembly, including serving five (5) terms as the Speaker of the Senate, the new tunnel that connects the Cordell Hull Building to the State Capitol is designated the "Ron Ramsey Tunnel".

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
