AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 7, Chapter 56, Part 2, relative to rail service.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 7-56-203(a), is amended by adding the following new subdivision:

- () If a county having a population of not less than sixty-one thousand one hundred (61,100) and not more than sixty-one thousand two hundred (61,200), according to the 2020 federal or a subsequent federal census, establishes or continues to operate a previously established authority, then the county must have a board of directors consisting of three (3) or five (5) members, as determined by the county legislative body. If the board of directors consists of:
 - (A) Three (3) members, then the membership is composed of the county mayor or the mayor's designee and two (2) members selected by the county legislative body; or
 - (B) Five (5) members, then the membership is composed of the county mayor or the mayor's designee; one (1) member selected by the county mayor; and three (3) members selected by the county legislative body.

SECTION 2. This act takes effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
