HOUSE BILL 2790

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 7; Title 47, Chapter 18 and Title 65, relative to smart meters.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 65, Chapter 4, Part 1, is amended by adding the following language as a new section:

- (a) As used in this section:
- (1) "Electric utility" means any public utility as defined in § 65-4-101 that is engaged in the sale or distribution of electricity ultimately sold to the public;
- (2) "Natural gas utility" means any public utility as defined in § 65-4-101 that is engaged in the sale or distribution of natural gas ultimately sold to the public; and
- (3) "Smart meter" means any electric or natural gas utility meter, utility meter component, utility meter load control device or any device ancillary to the utility meter that:
 - (A) Is located on or in a customer's residence, business, or structure; and
 - (B) Communicates with, monitors, measures, records, reports, stores, restricts, or regulates electrical or natural gas powered appliances, equipment, or devices.
- (b) No electric or natural gas utility that sells or provides electricity or natural gas in this state shall:

- (1) Install a smart meter on or in a customer's residence, business, or structure without the customer's written and signed consent;
- (2) Discontinue service to a customer if the customer declines to install or use a smart meter;
- (3) Charge a customer any fee for not installing or using a smart meter; or
- (4) Charge a customer any fee to remove a smart meter from the customer's residence, business, or structure.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2018, the public welfare requiring it.
