AN ACT to amend Chapter 330 of the Acts of 1901; as amended by Chapter 99 of the Private Acts of 1943; and any other acts amendatory thereto, relative to terms of the board of directors of the Tenth Special School District of Wilson County.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Chapter 330 of the Acts of 1901, as amended by Chapter 99 of the Private Acts of 1943, and any other acts amendatory thereto, is amended by adding the following after "year 1944." in Section 2:

Beginning with the 2022 August election, the terms of the Board of Directors or Commissioners of the Tenth Special School District shall be for a term of four years.

SECTION 2. Nothing in this act shall be construed to remove any incumbent from office or abridge the term of any incumbent prior to the end of the term for which an elected official was selected.

SECTION 3. This act takes effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
