HOUSE BILL NO. 2910

AN ACT to amend Chapter 57 of the Private Acts of 2016; and any other acts amendatory thereto, relative to the charter of the City of Rocky Top.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Chapter 57 of the Private Acts of 2016, and any other acts amendatory thereto, is amended by adding the following language at the end of Section 5(1):

No person shall be eligible for the office of mayor or councilperson who has not been a resident of the City of Rocky Top for one (1) year immediately preceding the election.

SECTION 2. This act shall have no effect unless it is approved by a two-thirds (2/3) vote of the legislative body of the City of Rocky Top. Its approval or nonapproval shall be proclaimed by the presiding officer of the legislative body and certified to the secretary of state.

SECTION 3. For the purpose of approving or rejecting the provisions of this act, it shall be effective upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it. For all other purposes, it becomes effective as provided in Section 2.
