## HOUSE BILL 2911

## AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 36, relative to grandparent visitation.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 36-6-306(c), is amended by deleting the subsection and substituting the following:

(c) Upon an initial finding of danger of substantial harm to the child, the court

must then determine whether grandparent visitation would be in the best interests of the

child based upon the factors in § 36-6-307. Upon such determination, reasonable

visitation may be ordered. Reasonable visitation must constitute, at a minimum,

sufficient contact to reasonably permit a strong and meaningful relationship to be

established with the child.

SECTION 2. This act takes effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it,

and applies to petitions filed with a court on or after the effective date of this act.
