

HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION 82

A RESOLUTION to honor Tee Higgins for his many accomplishments.

WHEREAS, the members of this legislative body are pleased to honor a student athlete who has brought great acclaim and honor to the Volunteer State as a national champion in college football; and

WHEREAS, Tee Higgins, a native of Oak Ridge and a graduate of Oak Ridge High School, is a proud and productive member of the Clemson University Tigers football team that recently won the 2018 College Football Playoff (CFP) National Championship; and

WHEREAS, excelling as a wide receiver during his sophomore season at Clemson, Tee Higgins was selected to the All-ACC (Atlantic Coast Conference) Second Team, was twice named ACC Receiver of the Week (in games versus South Carolina and Texas A&M), and earned Clemson Co-Offensive Player of the Week honors for his performance against North Carolina State, against whom he caught a career-high 8 passes for 119 yards, including a 46-yard touchdown reception; and

WHEREAS, he made two touchdown grabs in the second quarter of the Florida State game, and versus Louisville, Tee Higgins became the first Clemson player to record a touchdown reception in four consecutive games since 2016; and

WHEREAS, Tee Higgins then caught two touchdown passes in the ACC Championship Game against Pittsburgh and made an acrobatic, one-handed touchdown grab against Notre Dame in Clemson's Cotton Bowl victory; and

WHEREAS, in the CFP Championship Game versus Alabama, Tee Higgins posted 3 catches for 81 yards and scored the final touchdown on a 5-yard reception to put the icing on Clemson's national championship campaign; and

WHEREAS, for the 2018 season and CFP, Tee Higgins had 59 receptions for 936 yards, including 12 touchdown catches, and distinguished himself as one of Clemson's most talented receivers; and

WHEREAS, a two-sport standout at Oak Ridge, Mr. Higgins was honored as Tennessee Mr. Football for the Class 5A level in both 2015 and 2016, was named Class 5A Back of the Year by the Tennessee Titans in 2015, and was a finalist for Tennessee Mr. Basketball as a junior; and

WHEREAS, he was the highest rated signee in Clemson's 2017 recruiting class and was ranked as the second best high school receiver in the nation by Rivals; and

WHEREAS, Tee Higgins has accomplished a great deal at a young age, but we are certain that an even brighter future lies ahead; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE ONE HUNDRED ELEVENTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE, THE SENATE CONCURRING, that we honor and congratulate Tee Higgins on his instrumental role in the Clemson Tigers' 2018 National Championship season and wish him all the best in his future endeavors.
