

HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION 104

A RESOLUTION to confirm the appointment of Keri McInnis to the state university board of Austin Peay State University.

WHEREAS, Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 49-8-101, provides for the governance of Austin Peay State University by a state university board; and

WHEREAS, Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 49-8-201, provides that the governor shall appoint eight (8) members to the state university board of Austin Peay State University; and

WHEREAS, Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 49-8-201, further provides that at least three (3) of the gubernatorial appointees shall be alumni of the institution for which they are serving and that at least six (6) of the nine (9) voting members of the state university board shall be residents of the state of Tennessee; and

WHEREAS, Governor Bill Lee has appointed Keri McInnis to the state university board of Austin Peay State University for a term that will expire on June 30, 2026; and

WHEREAS, a highly successful businesswoman, Ms. McInnis is the senior vice president and financial advisor for Pinnacle Financial Partners' Green Hills office in Nashville; she a graduate of Austin Peay State University, a founder and board chair of the Austin Peay State University College of Business advisory board, and former member of the APSU Foundation Board of Trustees; and

WHEREAS, Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 49-8-201, provides that each member appointed by the governor to the state university board of Austin Peay State University shall be subject to confirmation by the senate and the house of representatives; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE ONE HUNDRED
TWELFTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE, THE SENATE
CONCURRING, that we hereby confirm the appointment of Keri McInnis to the state university
board of Austin Peay State University for a term that will expire on June 30, 2026.
