

HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION 207

A RESOLUTION to confirm the appointment of Robin Morrison as a commissioner of the Tennessee public utility commission.

WHEREAS, Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 65-1-101, creates the Tennessee public utility commission; and

WHEREAS, Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 65-1-101(a), provides that one (1) commissioner of the Tennessee public utility commission shall be appointed by the Speaker of the Senate; and

WHEREAS, Speaker of the Senate Randy McNally has appointed Robin Morrison of Chattanooga to serve a six-year term as a commissioner of the Tennessee public utility commission for a term that will expire on June 30, 2026; and

WHEREAS, Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 65-1-101(f), provides that each appointment to the commission shall be confirmed by joint resolution of the General Assembly; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE ONE HUNDRED TWELFTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE, THE SENATE CONCURRING, that we hereby confirm the appointment of Robin Morrison of Chattanooga to serve a six-year term as a commissioner of the Tennessee public utility commission, such term to expire on June 30, 2026.
