HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION 252

WHEREAS, in the sectional round, the Lady Eagles beat Moore County 43-32 to advance to the state tourney; and

WHEREAS, in the TSSAA Class A State Tournament quarterfinals, the Summertown Lady Eagles were matched up against the formidable Dresden Lady Lions, who despite their best efforts fell to the youth movement employed by Summertown; and WHEREAS, led by two eighth-graders, Jenna Brazier (17 points, 1 assist) and Kaley Campbell (11 points, 5 rebounds, 2 assists), and a point guard battling stomach flu, Reily Brazier (10 points, 2 rebounds, 1 assist), the Lady Eagles soared over the competition to emerge victorious by a score of 64-52; and

WHEREAS, in the semifinal round, Summertown came up short against the eventual state champions despite an outstanding effort by senior Madison Dinwiddie; playing in her final game for the Lady Eagles, Madison recorded 22 points, 4 rebounds, and 1 assist while playing 30 of 32 minutes of game time; and

WHEREAS, the other members of the district and regional champion Summertown squad are: Taytum McGill, Hayley Durham, A.J. Nelson, Rachel Barker, Alexis Perry, Kylie Rosson, Haley Brown, Josie Franks, Ashlee Pimental, Hailey Jones, Brooklyn Gabel, Cheyenne Jones, and Anisten Burleson; and

WHEREAS, during this outstanding season, the Lady Eagles were blessed with the talent and motivational skills of head coach, Craig McGill; and

WHEREAS, the entire Summertown community is very proud of the Lady Eagles and their magical 2016-2017 season and so are the members of this General Assembly; now, therefore,
