WHEREAS, active in her community, Carolyn Metz organized collections for Haiti, the American Cancer Organization, and Diabetes Prevention, and she contributed her time and talents to several fundraisers to benefit St. Jude's Children Hospital; additionally, she is a member of Modern Woodmen of the World, a fraternal insurance organization that promotes different efforts to benefit communities through fundraisers for schools and fire departments; and
