A RESOLUTION recognizing Tracey Rains, recipient of the Kennedy Center/Stephen Sondheim Inspirational Teacher Award.

WHEREAS, this Kennedy Center honor is competitively awarded to teachers who have had an extraordinary impact on the lives of their students, and comes to Mrs. Rains for the intellectual stimulation and encouragement she gave Ms. Hayes in their teacher-student relationship; and

WHEREAS, beyond that, Mrs. Rains fulfilled an even greater role of responsibility when Ms. Hayes's mother was seriously injured during Chelsea's junior year and unable to fully support her daughter. Mrs. Rains made sure Chelsea's daily needs were met, and that her aspirations for higher education were nurtured and allowed to flourish; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Hayes attributes her current life as a Duke University graduate and student at the University of Kentucky School of Law as flowing from the direct influence that Tracey Rains has had in her life; and

WHEREAS, Tracey Rains personifies the best qualities in training and supporting students during the critical years of their secondary educations, and the members of this General Assembly are pleased to recognize her at this time; now, therefore,
