WHEREAS, a 1985 graduate of Red Boiling Springs High School, Marsha Sue Bilbrey ranks second in school history in steals (291) and eighth in assists (335), as she helped the Lady Bulldogs compile a 70-48 record over her career with 20-win seasons in 1984 and 1985; and

WHEREAS, no stranger to awards and accolades, she was an honorable mention selection on the 5-A All-District Team in 1983-1984 and a 5-A All-District Selection in 1984-1985, having helped Red Boiling Springs advance to the regional tournament in 1984 and win the Red Boiling Springs Christmas Tournament in 1985, receiving all-tournament honors; and

WHEREAS, during her junior high career, Marsha Sue Bilbrey led her team to the 1981 state title and earned Most Valuable Player honors, having averaged 25.3 points per game over the three-game tournament; and

WHEREAS, Marsha Sue Bilbrey demonstrated leadership, skill, and athleticism on the basketball court, and she should be recognized on this special occasion; now, therefore,
