WHEREAS, most importantly, Shannon McCloud has given her heart and soul to fight for the lives of the most defenseless among us, serving as a vocal advocate for the 103 children who, because of her work and the work of the organization, are healthy and living in loving homes. She has also helped ensure that there have been no unsafe or illegal abandonments in the last four years; and

WHEREAS, Ms. McCloud epitomizes the spirit and commitment that are characteristic of a true Tennessean, and she should be specially recognized for her many accomplishments and devoted work; now, therefore,
