A RESOLUTION to honor and commend the Christian Cooperative Ministry of Madison.

Calvary Baptist Church, Mt. Vernon Missionary Baptist Church, Neely's Bend Baptist Church, New Life Baptist Church, and Parkway Baptist Church; and WHEREAS, it is fitting that we recognize such an exemplary organization on this special occasion; now, therefore,
