

HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION 719

A RESOLUTION to confirm the appointment of Dean Mills of Bean Station to the State Textbook and Instructional Materials Quality Commission.

WHEREAS, Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 49-6-2201, provides for the creation of the State Textbook and Instructional Materials Quality Commission; and

WHEREAS, Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 49-6-2201(a)(1)(C)(ii), provides that the governor appoint a teacher or instructional supervisor in the upper grade subjects, grades nine through twelve (9-12); and

WHEREAS, Governor Bill Lee, acting pursuant to Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 49-6-2201(a)(1)(C)(ii), has appointed Dean Mills of Bean Station as a member of the State Textbook and Instructional Materials Quality Commission for a term that will expire on June 30, 2021; and

WHEREAS, Dean Mills is an automotive teacher at Grainger High School and a bus driver for the Grainger County School System; his students have earned industry certifications in ASE and PMI through NC3 and won awards competing at the Top Wrench Competition held at McGhee Tyson Air National Guard Base and now Crown College, with a total of \$60,000 in scholarships to attend Lincoln Tech in Nashville; and

WHEREAS, Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 49-6-2201(b)(1), provides that each appointed member shall be confirmed by joint resolution of the General Assembly; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE ONE HUNDRED ELEVENTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE, THE SENATE

CONCURRING, that we hereby confirm the appointment of Dean Mills to the State Textbook and Instructional Materials Quality Commission for a term that will expire on June 30, 2021.
