A RESOLUTION to honor and congratulate Dr. Nancy B. Moody on being named the 27<sup>th</sup> President of Tusculum College in Greeneville.

WHEREAS, it is appropriate that the members of this General Assembly should recognize those exemplary individuals whose intense dedication and hard work have had a significant impact on the State of Tennessee; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Nancy B. Moody is one such outstanding citizen who is most certainly deserving of special recognition; and

WHEREAS, in April 2009, Dr. Nancy Moody was inaugurated as the 27<sup>th</sup> President of Tusculum College in Greeneville, an educational institution highly regarded for excellence; she is the College's first female president; and

WHEREAS, she is a strong advocate of Tusculum College's Civic Arts curriculum and is well-known and respected in the region; and

WHEREAS, she previously served from 2002-2009 as president of Lincoln Memorial University; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Moody is the immediate past chair of the Executive Committee for the Tennessee Independent Colleges and Universities Association and served on the Tennessee Student Assistance Corporation Board of Directors. She is a member of the NCAA Division II President's Council and an active participant on the boards of the Appalachian Colleges Association and the Tennessee Center for Nursing, Inc; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Moody received associate and baccalaureate degrees in nursing from Eastern Kentucky University, a Master's of Science in Nursing from Texas Woman's University

and a Doctorate of Science in Nursing from the University of Alabama School of Nursing at Birmingham; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Moody has spent her professional career in all three systems of higher education in Tennessee: private higher education, a Tennessee Board of Regents institution, and the University of Tennessee; and

WHEREAS, she is married to Tom Moody, a self-employed public accountant. She and Tom are the proud parents of daughter, Mykel, and son, Adam; and

WHEREAS, it is appropriate that the members of this General Assembly should recognize the outstanding service this remarkable woman has rendered to our state, now, therefore;

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE ONE HUNDRED EIGHTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE, THE SENATE CONCURRING, that we hereby honor and commend Dr. Nancy B.
