to increase STEM achievement and the number and diversity of students entering the STEM workforce; now in its seventh year, Aspirnaut has positively impacted more than 2,000 students; and

WHEREAS, throughout her exemplary tenure with Vanderbilt, Dr. Hudson has distinguished herself as a public-spirited citizen of the highest order and an exceptional asset to the greater Nashville community; and
