A RESOLUTION to urge the Tennessee Higher Education

minimum number of hours for a student to be
considered a full-time student.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE ONE HUNDRED SIXTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE, that the Tennessee Higher Education Commission, the University of Tennessee, and the Tennessee Board of Regents are hereby urged to set the minimum number of hours undertaken by a student that are necessary for such student to be considered a full-time student in this state as fourteen (14) hours.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that appropriate copies of this resolution be prepared and forwarded to the Executive Director of the Tennessee Higher Education Commission, the Chancellor of the Tennessee Board of Regents, and the President of the University of Tennessee.
