

SENATE BILL 36

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 40,
Chapter 29, Part 2, relative to restoration of voting
rights.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 40-29-202, is amended by deleting subsections (b) and (c) in their entireties and substituting instead the following:

(b) Notwithstanding subsection (a), a person shall not be eligible to apply for a voter registration card and have the right of suffrage restored, unless the person:

(1) Has paid all restitution to the victim or victims of the offense ordered by the court as part of the sentence or is making installment payments in accordance with a court-authorized payment plan;

(2) Has paid all assessed court costs, is making payments in accordance with a court-approved payment plan, or has had the person's outstanding court costs waived by the court as a result of the person's indigency; and

(3) Is current in all child support obligations, is making payments in accordance with a plan for payment of overdue support, or has an income assignment in effect and is paying pursuant to § 36-5-501.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2019, the public welfare requiring it.
