AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 55, Chapter 21, Part 1, relative to parking privileges for persons with disabilities.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 55, Chapter 21, Part 1, is amended by adding the following as a new section:

The department of revenue is urged to study the issue of enforcement of disabled parking violations of § 55-21-108 and local ordinances and resolutions relative to parking privileges for persons with disabilities. If such study is conducted, then on or before February 1, 2020, the department shall report its findings and recommendations to the transportation and safety committee of the senate and the transportation committee of the house of representatives, which report shall include any available data regarding the violations and recommendations on public education and enforcement of § 55-21-108 and local ordinances and resolutions relative to parking privileges for persons with disabilities. This section is deleted on July 1 following the date on which the department submits its report, if any such study is conducted. The commissioner of revenue shall certify in writing to the executive secretary of the Tennessee code commission the date on which the report is submitted and provide the executive secretary of the commission with a copy of such report.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring

it.
