AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 4, Chapter 29 and Title 58, Chapter 7, relative to the Tennessee state veterans' homes board.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 4-29-240(a), is amended by deleting subdivision (51).

SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 4-29-244(a), is amended by inserting the following language as a new, appropriately designated subdivision:

() Tennessee state veterans' homes board, created by § 58-7-102;

SECTION 3. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 58-7-103(a), is amended by deleting the subsection and substituting instead the following:

The board shall elect a chair from among its members. The chair shall be a citizen of the state and an honorably discharged veteran of the United States armed forces. The chair shall serve a two-year term. A chair may be reelected; provided, that no person shall serve as chair for more than two (2) consecutive terms.


SECTION 4. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
