SENATE BILL 146

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 38, Chapter 3, Part 1, relative to firearm laws.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 38-3-115, is amended by adding the following new subsection (c) and by redesignating accordingly:

(c)

- (1) On or after July 1, 2017, no public funds of this state, or any political subdivision of this state, shall be allocated to the implementation, regulation, or enforcement of any federal law, executive order, rule, or regulation regulating the ownership, use, or possession of firearms, ammunition, or firearm accessories.
- (2) On or after July 1, 2017, no personnel or property of this state, or any political subdivision of this state, shall be allocated to the implementation, regulation, or enforcement of any federal law, executive order, rule, or regulation regulating the ownership, use, or possession of firearms, ammunition, or firearm accessories.
- (3) On or after July 1, 2017, no personnel or property of this state, or any political subdivision of this state, shall be allocated to the implementation, regulation, or enforcement of any international law or treaty regulating the ownership, use, or possession of firearms, ammunition, or firearm accessories.
- (4) On or after July 1, 2017, no public funds of this state, or any political subdivision of this state, shall be allocated to the implementation, regulation, or enforcement of any international law or treaty regulating the ownership, use, or possession of firearms, ammunition, or firearm accessories.

SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 38-3-115, is amended by deleting from subdivision (a)(1) and (a)(2) the language "On or after July 1, 2015," and substituting instead the language "From July 1, 2015, until June 30, 2017,".

SECTION 3. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 38-3-115, is amended by deleting from subdivision (b)(1) and (b)(2) the language "On or after July 1, 2016," and substituting instead the language "From July 1, 2016, until June 30, 2017,".

SECTION 4. This act shall take effect July 1, 2017, the public welfare requiring it.
