

SENATE BILL 192

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 4;
Title 10 and Title 68, Chapter 3, relative to vital
records.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 68-3-308(a), is amended by
designating the existing language as subdivision (1) and adding the following subdivision:

(2) Notwithstanding subdivision (a)(1), the state registrar has discretion to issue
a delayed birth certificate based upon finding that a preponderance of the evidence
weighs in favor of an applicant. Evidence the state registrar may consider includes, but
is not limited to, obituaries and birth and death certificates of parents or siblings; property
tax records; sworn affidavits from two (2) or more county officials; and other alternative
documentary evidence that may support the applicant's claimed place of birth.

SECTION 2. This act takes effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
