## **PUBLIC CHAPTER NO. 15**

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 2, Chapter 4, relative to elections.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 2-4-102(a), is amended by deleting the language "Not more than sixty (60) days" and substituting instead the language "Not more than ninety (90) days".

SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 2-4-109, is amended by designating the existing language as subsection (a) and adding the following language as a new subsection (b):

Notwithstanding subsection (a), a person may volunteer to provide services under subsection (a) without compensation.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
