## **SENATE BILL 249**

## By Massey

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 2, Chapter 2, relative to voting rights.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 2-2-107(a), is amended by adding the following as a new subdivision:

- (4) Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, if a municipal charter provides for property rights voting, the members of a limited liability company chartered in this state that owns property in the municipality are entitled to vote; provided, that:
  - (A) Only two (2) members may vote based upon the ownership of an individual tract of property regardless of the number of members of the limited liability company;
    - (B) The individuals voting are residents of this state; and
    - (C) An individual shall not vote more than once in an election.

SECTION 2. This act takes effect July 1, 2021, the public welfare requiring it.
