AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 4, Chapter 32, relative to the financial activities of the governor's office of faith-based and community initiatives.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 4-32-103(e), is amended by deleting the subsection and substituting:


(e) A state employee shall not receive compensation from funds received by the nonprofit partner pursuant to subsection (d).

SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 4-32-104(a), is amended by deleting the subsection.

SECTION 3. This act takes effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
