

SENATE BILL 304

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 57,  
relative to alcohol.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 57-3-101(a)(1)(A), is amended by deleting the language "regardless of alcohol content" and substituting "having an alcohol content of more than ten and one-tenth of one percent (10.1%) by volume".

SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 57-5-101(b), is amended by deleting the language "eight percent (8%) by weight" and substituting "ten and one-tenth of one percent (10.1%) by volume, regardless of the process by which it was manufactured or the fruit, grain, or product from which the alcohol was derived".

SECTION 3. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 57-3-101(a)(9), is amended by deleting the language "eight percent (8%) by weight" and substituting "ten and one-tenth of one percent (10.1%) by volume"; and by deleting "twenty percent (20%) by weight" and substituting "twenty-five and three-tenths of one percent (25.3%) by volume".

SECTION 4. This act takes effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
