

SENATE BILL 307

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 67,  
Chapter 6, relative to sales of reading materials  
required by educational institutions.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 67-6-102, is amended by deleting the language ""Textbook" means a printed book that contains systematically organized educational information that covers the primary objectives of a course of study." and substituting instead the following language:

"Textbook" means a printed book that contains systematically organized educational information that covers the primary objectives of a course of study, or other reading material that is required for a course by any high school or other secondary educational institution or any postsecondary educational institution and that is purchased by a student who possesses a valid student identification card or other proof of current enrollment at any high school or postsecondary educational institution and who possesses a valid, current course syllabus containing the name of the required textbook.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2017, the public welfare requiring it.
