AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 7-51-2102, relative to energy sources.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 7-51-2102(a), is amended by deleting the subsection and substituting the following:

(a) A political subdivision of this state shall not adopt a policy that prohibits, or has the effect of prohibiting, based upon the type or source of energy to be delivered to or used by an individual customer:

- (1) The connection or reconnection of a utility service; or
- (2) The sale or installation of an appliance utilized for cooking, space heating, water heating, or another end use.

SECTION 2. This act takes effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
