SENATE BILL 450

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 39, Chapter 17, Part 4, possession of a controlled substance.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 39-17-418(a), is amended by deleting the subsection in its entirety and by substituting instead the following:

(a)

- (1) It is an offense for a person to knowingly possess a controlled substance as defined in § 39-17-402(4), whether internally or externally, or casually exchange a controlled substance.
- (2) The presence of any amount of a controlled substance in a lawfully obtained sample of a person's bodily fluid is evidence of internal possession under subdivision (a)(1).
- (3) It is an exception to an offense under subsection (a) that the person obtained the substance directly from, or pursuant to, a valid prescription or order of a practitioner while acting in the course of professional practice and the controlled substance present in the bodily fluid sample, is the same controlled substance for which the person has a valid prescription or order.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2011, the public welfare requiring it.
