SENATE BILL 606

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 4; Title 5; Title 6; Title 7; Title 8; Title 38 and Title 49, relative to the training of law enforcement.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 38-8-104, is amended by adding the following language as a new subsection:

(g) The commission shall consult and cooperate with LEAs to develop, plan, and

implement a school patrol zone plan where local law enforcement shall patrol LEAs at

least two (2) times a day during the school week. The assigned law enforcement

personnel shall:

- (1) Stop at the school and check in at the front office of the school;
- (2) Check both the inside and outside school buildings;
- (3) Monitor school entrances;
- (4) Assess security procedures;
- (5) Provide a visible law enforcement presence each school day, in

addition to the school resource officers;

- (6) Vary the patrol schedule so routines are not established; and
- (7) Adopt and enforce such any additional rules and regulations as may

be necessary to carry out the provisions of this section.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2013, the public welfare requiring it.
