SENATE BILL 670

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 62, Chapter 3, relative to barbering.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

- SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 62-3-123, is amended by adding the following language as a new subsection (e):
 - (e) Notwithstanding subsection (a), the board shall promulgate rules enabling a barber school or college to develop courses of instruction pursuant to subsection (a) that require a student to earn:
 - (1) Fifty percent (50%) of the hours needed for a specific certificate of registration pursuant to §§ 62-3-110 and 62-3-124, from classroom instruction in a registered barber school or college; and
 - (2) Fifty percent (50%) of the hours needed for a specific certificate of registration pursuant to §§ 62-3-110 and 62-3-124, from apprenticing under the supervision of a person:
 - (A) Who has a certificate of registration issued under §§ 62-3-110 and 62-3-124:
 - (B) Who has at least ten (10) years of experience; and
 - (C) Who is in good standing with the board.

SECTION 2. The board of cosmetology and barber examiners is authorized to promulgate rules to effectuate the purposes of this act. All rules shall be promulgated in accordance with the Uniform Administrative Procedures Act, compiled in title 4, chapter 5.

SECTION 3. For the purpose of promulgating rules, this act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it. For all other purposes, this act shall take effect January 1, 2016, the public welfare requiring it.
