## **SENATE BILL 676**

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 63, relative to the use of professional titles.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 63-1-109, is amended by adding the following as a new subsection:

Notwithstanding a law to the contrary, a person shall not use the title "anesthesiologist" or another title, abbreviation, or designation in connection with the person's name, occupation, or profession, to indicate or imply that the person is a practicing anesthesiologist, unless the person is:

- (1) A physician who:
- (A) Is actively licensed by the board of medical examiners under chapter 6 of this title, or the board of osteopathic examination under chapter 9 of this title;
  - (B) Has completed a residency in anesthesiology; and
- (C) Has a practice that is primarily limited to anesthesiology, including, without limitation, nerve block; pain management; cardiac and respiratory resuscitation; respiratory therapy; management of fluids and electrolyte and metabolic disturbances; or
- (2) A dentist licensed in this state who completed a residency program in anesthesiology at an accredited medical school in years 1963 through 1977.

SECTION 2. This act takes effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it, and applies to actions taken on or after the effective date of this act.
