AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 39 and Title 40, relative to crimes committed against minors.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 39, Chapter 13, Part 6, is amended by adding the following new section:

39-13-611.

- (a) A person commits the offense of aggravated unlawful photographing when the person knowingly photographs, or causes to be photographed a minor, when the minor has a reasonable expectation of privacy, if the photograph:
 - (1) Depicts the minor in a state of nudity; and
 - (2) Was taken for the purpose of sexual arousal or gratification of the defendant.
 - (b) As used in this section:
 - (1) "Nudity" has the meaning given in § 39-17-901; and
 - (2) "Photograph" has the meaning given in § 39-13-605.
 - (c) A violation of subsection (a) is a Class C felony.
- (d) Nothing in this section shall preclude the state from electing to prosecute conduct in violation of this section under any other applicable section, including chapter 17, parts 9 and 10 of this title.
- SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 40-39-202(20)(A), is amended by adding the following new subdivision:
 - () Aggravated unlawful photography, under § 39-13-611;
 - SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon becoming law, the public welfare requiring it.
