SENATE BILL 711

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 34-7-104, relative to the district public guardian.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 34-7-104, is amended by adding the following as a new subsection:

- (1) Notwithstanding subsection (a) to the contrary, the executive director of the Tennessee commission on aging and disability may request the district public guardian to serve as a conservator for disabled persons who are younger than sixty (60) years of age if the following conditions are met:
 - (A) The request is made through a court; and
 - (B) The court has found on the record that:
 - (i) There are no other less intrusive alternatives available for the disabled person; and
 - (ii) The disabled person has no family members or other person, bank, or corporation willing and able to serve as conservator.
- (2) Should the district public guardian take on the responsibilities of a guardian for a disabled person pursuant to this subsection (1), the guardian must adhere, in performing the guardian's duty, to all provisions of this chapter and to all applicable state laws.
- SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring

it.
