SENATE BILL 747

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 68, relative to disease control and prevention.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 68-11-266, is amended by deleting the section and substituting:

In accordance with the latest recommendations of the advisory committee on immunization practices of the federal centers for disease control and prevention, unless contraindicated and subject to the availability of vaccine, a hospital shall:

- (1) Each year from October 1 through March 1, prior to discharging an inpatient who is fifty (50) years of age or older, offer the inpatient immunization for influenza disease; and
- (2) Prior to discharging an inpatient who is sixty-five (65) years of age or older, offer the inpatient immunization for pneumococcal disease.

SECTION 2. This act takes effect July 1, 2023, the public welfare requiring it.
