

SENATE BILL 966

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 54  
and Title 55, relative to driver licenses.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 55-50-409, is amended by deleting subsection (a) in its entirety and by substituting instead the following:

(a)

(1) Within two (2) calendar weeks after receiving a report of the conviction of any resident or nonresident holder of a commercial driver license of any violation of state law or local ordinance relating to motor vehicle traffic control, other than parking violations, committed in a commercial motor vehicle, the department shall notify the driver licensing authority in the licensing state of the conviction and the commercial driver license information system.

(2) Within two (2) calendar weeks after the conviction of any resident or nonresident holder of a commercial driver license of any violation of state law or local ordinance relating to motor vehicle traffic control, other than a parking violation, committed in a commercial motor vehicle, the clerk of the court of jurisdiction shall notify the department of the conviction.

(3) The notice provided pursuant to subdivision (2) shall contain:

- (A) The name and residence address of the driver;
- (B) Date of birth;
- (C) Driver license number and state of issuance;
- (D) The violation of which the person was convicted;

- (E) A statement that the person was in fact operating a commercial motor vehicle;
- (F) The amount of any fine or costs assessed for the violation;
- (G) The name of the arresting agency; and
- (H) The name of the county and court in which the conviction occurred.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2009, the public welfare requiring it.
