AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 70, Chapter 2, relative to hunting and fishing licenses.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 70-2-104, is amended by adding the following as a new, appropriately designated subsection:

(f)

- (1) Notwithstanding this section to the contrary, the wildlife resources director and the director's agents, through the county clerks or other legally designated license sales agents, shall issue a sport hunting and fishing license upon payment of an annual ten-dollar fee to the following persons who reside outside this state and who are fifty percent (50%) service connected disabled:
 - (A) Combat veterans;
 - (B) Police officers;
 - (C) Firefighters; and
 - (D) Emergency medical technicians.
- (2) The agency shall accept as evidence of service-connected disability for the purposes of this section a certification from:
 - (A) The veterans administration for persons listed in subdivision(f)(1)(A); and
 - (B) A physician licensed pursuant to title 63, chapter 6 or 9, for persons listed in subdivisions (f)(1)(B)–(D).

SECTION 2. For the purpose of promulgating rules, this act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it. For all other purposes this act shall take effect September 15, 2015, the public welfare requiring it.
