AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 57-3-207, relative to the grape and wine law.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 57-3-207, is amended by adding the following language as a new subsection (q) and renumbering the subsequent subsections accordingly:

(q) A winery licensed under this section shall be allowed to sell not more than three thousland (3,000) cases each calendar year of wine produced or finished on the winery's premises to restaurants and hotels licensed to serve wine, for consumption on premises. Such winery shall be permitted to transport the wine to the restaurants and hotels purchasing the wine pursuant to rules promulgated by the alcoholic beverage commission.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring

it.
