

SENATE BILL 1247

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 3,
Chapter 1, Part 1, relative to expenses of
members of the general assembly.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 3-1-106, is amended by adding a
new subsection thereto, as follows:

(h)

(1) Notwithstanding any provision of this section to the contrary, each
member of the house of representatives and the senate, except for the
respective speakers of each house, shall each calendar year be limited to one (1)
conference, symposium, workshop, assemblage or other official gathering
concerning state business and the duties of a legislator held outside the state of
Tennessee.

(2) Each member of the house of representatives and the senate, except
for the respective speakers of each house, shall be limited to one (1) conference,
symposium, workshop, assemblage or other official gathering concerning state
business and the duties of a legislator held outside the United States every four
(4) years.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect November 2, 2010, the public welfare requiring it.
