## SENATE BILL 1270

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 55, Chapter 25 and Title 63, Chapter 1, Part 1, relative to solicitation of accident and disaster victims.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

- SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 55-25-112, is amended by deleting the section and substituting the following:
  - (a) Any person requesting the disclosure of personal information from department records who misrepresents that person's identity or makes a false statement to the department on any application required to be submitted pursuant to this chapter commits a Class C misdemeanor, punishable only by a fine not to exceed five thousand dollars (\$5,000) per violation.
  - (b) Any person who knowingly releases personal information from department records to an unauthorized person commits a Class C misdemeanor, punishable only by a fine not to exceed five thousand dollars (\$5,000) per violation.
- SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 63-1-129, is amended by adding the following as a new subsection:
  - (f) The division is authorized to take disciplinary action, up to and including, suspension or revocation of a license, certificate, permit, or authorization, of any healthcare prescriber, employee, agent, or independent contractor found in violation of this section.
  - SECTION 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2019, the public welfare requiring it.
