## SENATE BILL 1280

## By Jackson

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 8 and Title 16, relative to the compensation of public officers and employees.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 8-7-230(a), is amended by deleting the subsection and substituting instead:

(a) Beginning July 1, 2023, all criminal investigators must be compensated according to the following pay schedule, which begins for entry-level positions, at a rate equal to thirty-five percent (35%) of the annual compensation of the district attorney general, and concludes, after twenty (20) years of service, at a rate equal to fifty-five percent (55%) of the annual compensation of the district attorney general:

| After fourteen (14) years | \$83,160 |
| After sixteen (16) years  | \$86,555 |
| After eighteen (18) years | \$89,949 |
| After twenty (20) years   | \$93,343 |

SECTION 2. This act takes effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
