

SENATE BILL 1306

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 62,  
Chapter 4, relative to certain cause for  
suspension, revocation, or denial of license.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 62-4-127(b)(7), is amended by deleting the subdivision and substituting instead the following:

(7)

(A) Conviction of a felony, if the felony conviction occurred within five (5) years prior to the board's decision to suspend, revoke, or refuse to issue or renew the license; or

(B) Conviction of any misdemeanor involving moral turpitude, if the misdemeanor conviction occurred within two (2) years prior to the board's decision to suspend, revoke, or refuse to issue or renew the license;

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it, and shall apply to actions by the board on or after the effective date of this act.
