## SENATE BILL 1319

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 2-7-142, relative to polling places.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

- SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 2-7-142(b), is amended by deleting the subsection and substituting instead the following:
  - (1) Any voter using a mobile electronic or communication device as allowed in subsection (a) is prohibited from using the device for telephone conversations.
  - (2) Any voter using a mobile electronic or communication device as allowed in subsection (a) is permitted to use the device for recording or taking photographs or videos of the voter's marked ballot; provided, that the voter does not show another voter's ballot.
- SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 2-7-142, is amended by adding the following language as a new subsection (c):
  - (c) The election officials and poll watchers of each polling place may prohibit any disruptive activity that threatens the orderly process of voting or the privacy of another voter's ballot.
  - SECTION 3. This act shall take effect July 1, 2019, the public welfare requiring it.
