## HOUSE BILL NO. 926

#### **By Senator Swann**

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 39, Chapter 17, Part 18, relative to the employment of minors.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 39-17-1804, is amended by deleting subdivision (1) and substituting instead the following:

(1) Age-restricted venues; provided, that an age-restricted venue does not lose the exemption if an employee is:

(A) At least sixteen (16) years of age;

(B) Not employed at an adult-oriented establishment, as defined in § 7-51-1102; and

(C) A child of the owner of the age-restricted venue;

SECTION 2. This act takes effect July 1, 2021, the public welfare requiring it.
