SENATE BILL 1401

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 36 and Title 71, relative to children.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 36-4-106(b)(1), is amended by adding the following language immediately after the first sentence:

Further, at the time a complaint or a pleading responsive to the complaint is filed under this part, the filing party shall file a sworn affidavit as to whether the party has health insurance coverage in employer-based health coverage and whether any minor children of the marriage are eligible to be covered by the employer-based health coverage.

SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 36-4-116(b), is amended by deleting the language "may" and substituting instead the language "shall"; and is further amended by adding the language "whether the parties have health insurance coverage in employer-based health coverage and whether any minor children of the marriage are eligible to be covered by the employer-based health coverage," immediately after the language "their expenses,".

SECTION 3. This act takes effect July 1, 2023, the public welfare requiring it.
