## SENATE BILL 1447

## By Green

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Title 40, Chapter 2, Part 1, relative to sentencing.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 40-2-101, is amended by adding the following language as a new subsection:

(m) Notwithstanding subsections (a) and (b), prosecutions for any offense committed on or after July 1, 2016, that constitutes the felony offense of child abuse, or child neglect or endangerment, under § 39-15-401 or aggravated child abuse, or aggravated child neglect or endangerment, under § 39-15-402 shall commence no later than ten (10) years after the child reaches eighteen (18) years of age.

SECTION 2. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 40-2-102(a), is amended by deleting the language "Except as provided in § 62-18-120(g) and subsection (b) of this section" and substituting instead "Except as provided in subsections (b) and (c) of this section and § 62-18-120(g)".

SECTION 3. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 40-2-102, is further amended by adding the following language as a new subsection:

- (c) Prosecutions for any offense committed on or after July 1, 2016, that constitutes the misdemeanor offense of child abuse, or child neglect or endangerment, under § 39-15-401 shall commence no later than five (5) years after the child reaches eighteen (18) years of age.
- SECTION 4. This act shall take effect July 1, 2016, the public welfare requiring it.
