## **PRIVATE CHAPTER NO. 21**

#### HOUSE BILL NO. 1564

#### **By Senator Roberts**

AN ACT to amend Chapter 89 of the Private Acts of 2008; and any other acts amendatory thereto, relative to the Town of Burns.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Chapter 89 of the Private Acts of 2008, and any other acts amendatory thereto, is amended by deleting the first sentence from Section 5 and substituting:

On the second Monday in December, 2024, and on the second Monday in December every two (2) years thereafter, the incoming Board of Commissioners shall meet and organize.

SECTION 2. Chapter 89 of the Private Acts of 2008, and any other acts amendatory thereto, is amended by deleting from Section 9 the language "first Monday" and substituting "second Monday".

SECTION 3. This act has no effect unless it is approved by a two-thirds (2/3) vote of the legislative body of the Town of Burns. Its approval or nonapproval must be proclaimed by the presiding officer of the legislative body of the Town of Burns and certified to the secretary of state.

SECTION 4. For the purpose of approving or rejecting the provisions of this act, this act becomes effective upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it. For all other purposes, it becomes effective as provided in Section 3.
