

SENATE BILL 1581

AN ACT to amend Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 57-4-102, relative to consumption of alcoholic beverages in certain premier type tourist resorts in any county having a population of not less than twenty eight thousand three hundred seventy-five (28,375) nor more than twenty eight thousand four hundred fifty (28,450) according to the 2000 federal census or any subsequent federal census.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 57-4-102(24), is amended by adding the following as a new subdivision thereto:

(_) A commercially operated recreational facility located within a county having a population of not less than twenty-eight thousand three hundred seventy-five (28,375) nor more than twenty-eight thousand four hundred fifty (28,450), according to the 2000 federal census or any subsequent federal census.

SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it.
